

Supplemental Professional Development Funds for Conference Presentations

Effective Spring 2014, the English Department has supplemental professional development funding available for graduate students and faculty who are presenting their work at conferences. Funding is limited, and all applications for this funding are subject to review.

General Guidelines

- Applicants must be presenting their work at a conference
- Funding may only be used for conference-related activities (including registration fees, travel, and lodging)
- All requests will be reviewed by a committee comprised of the department chair and representatives from at least two other tracks
- A maximum of \$2500 will be disbursed per academic year

Eligibility Requirements / Funding Limits:

Fulltime Faculty

- Must have no remaining Article 19 money
- Individuals may receive no more than \$500 per academic year

Adjunct Faculty

- Must be employed by the English Department in the current academic year
- Individuals may receive no more than \$500 per academic year

Graduate Students

- Must be enrolled and in good academic standing in an English Department graduate program in the current academic year
- Individuals may receive no more than \$250 per academic year (graduate students are also encouraged to seek separate funding from the English Department, the Graduate College, and the GSEA)
