**Topics Courses:**

Students also may choose from the following English courses, **if** the topics offered are film-based. Currently approved topics are in bold.

ENG 211W (4 cr)	Perspectives: Human Diversity in Literature/Film ( <b>Topic: Women Filmmakers</b> )
ENG 212W (4 cr)	Perspectives: World Literature/Film ( <b>Topic: World Cinema</b> )
ENG 213W (4 cr)	Perspectives: Ethnics and Civic Responsibility in Literature/Film ( <b>Topics: Science Fiction Film/Literature, Horror Films, Fantasy Film/Literature</b> )

Students may choose electives from other departments that offer film or film-based topics classes. These departments include, but are not limited to, Philosophy and Mass Communications (the latter by permission only). Please consult the Film Studies Minor Advisor **before** taking any courses outside the English department.
